Anita Beaty holds a Bachelor of Music from the Eastman School of Music and a Master of Music from Indiana University where she studied on full scholarship. Her piano studies included training with Charles Reiner at McGill University and Evelyne Brancart at Indiana University. At the Eastman School of Music she studied composition with Warren Benson.

Ms. Beaty performs regularly as both a solo and collaborative pianist, and is a member of the chamber ensemble "Windsong". She has composed for film and websites including "Nancy Boy vs. Manly Woman" and "Chicken Soup for the Canadian Soul" and has been Musical Director for numerous live theatre productions, including Rick Millers' "MacHomer". Ms. Beaty also works with the Canadian Opera Company as an accompanist artist-educator.

In addition, Ms. Beaty has a large private teaching studio in Toronto. She is an active member of the Ontario Registered Music Teachers' Association. Recently she has developed "Kinder Keys" a method for introducing young beginners to the piano, and is currently working on a piano method for 7-9 year olds. In the past few years a number of her students have been chosen to perform concerti with their high school orchestras.
