Lynn Blaser holds an ARCT diploma in Voice Performance from The Royal Conservatory of Music, an Artist diploma from the University of Toronto Opera Department, and a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from York University. She also studied with Gina Cigna in Milan, with Tito Gobbi in Italy, and with leading coaches and conductors in Austria. She has sung major roles with the Canadian Opera Company, Opera in Concert, Opera Hamilton, Calgary Opera, and Theatre New Brunswick, and in operatic productions at the Algoma, Bermuda, Guelph, and Sharon Festivals. She has performed in concert and in solo recitals across Canada, and has had concert tours in the United States and Europe. Ms. Blaser has premiered a number of Canadian works including Portraits by Nancy Telfer, and Psalms of David by Milton Barnes.

Lynn Blaser combines a performing career with teaching and adjudicating. From 1990 to 1997 she was voice coach to the Ontario Youth Choir and currently, she is an adjunct Associate Professor of Voice at the University of Toronto. She maintains a large private studio in Toronto, conducts masterclasses, and serves as a festival adjudicator. Ms. Blaser is also currently President of the Ontario Chapter of the National Association of Teachers of Singing.
