Elaine Broughton holds an ARCT Diploma in Piano Performance and an ARCT Diploma in Voice Performer from The Royal Conservatory of Music and has studied organ, harmony and drama at the University of Toronto. Ms. Broughton has adjudicated for numerous festivals across Canada and has led masterclasses on topics including The Interpretation of Piano Literature of Baroque and Romantic Periods. For twenty-five years Ms. Broughton was director of the voice program at Trafalgar Castle School in Whitby where she taught voice, piano and theory, conducted the choral ensemble, and served as chapel organist.

Ms. Broughton was also a consultant in the establishment of the Newfoundland School of Music and has held executive positions in a number of music organizations including the Oshawa Concert Association, the Ontario Registered Music Teachers' Association, the Royal Canadian College of Organists, and the Royal School of Church Music. Currently, Ms. Broughton runs a busy music studio in Whitby, Ontario, is an active chamber musician and serves as Organist and Choir Director at All Saints Anglican Church in Whitby
