Karin Di Bella holds an ARCT Diploma in Piano Performance from The Royal Conservatory of Music. She completed an Honours Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Western Ontario, a Master of Music degree from Washington University in St. Louis, and a Doctorate of Musical Arts from the University of British Columbia.

Dr. Di Bella is an accomplished teacher and educator. Her areas of expertise include music and politics of the 1920s and 1930s, historical instruments and techniques of the 18th and 19th centuries, and contemporary Canadian repertoire, particularly works by Jack Behrens. She has appeared as a concerto soloist with orchestras in the United States and Canada, and has an active collaborative career with percussionists, string players, wind players, and vocalists around the continent. Previously on faculty at the Glenn Gould School of The Royal Conservatory of Music, Dr. Di Bella is currently Assistant Professor of Piano at Brock University where she teaches piano lessons, master classes, accompanying, and piano pedagogy.
