John Dupuis holds a Master of Music (Piano Performance) from the University of British Columbia and a Bachelor of Music (Piano Performance) from McGill University. Mr. Dupuis studied with many of Canada's best pianists, as well as distinguished European and American artists. He is an active soloist and collaborative musician who has performed with members of professional orchestras on both the east and west coasts, including the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra, the Vancouver Opera Orchestra, the CBC Radio Orchestra, the Richmond Orchestra and the Saint John Symphony Orchestra. He has given solo performances in North America, Europe and Asia.

As a teacher, Mr. Dupuis enjoys the privilege of working with some of British Columbia's most talented young musicians, many of whom have been recipients of significant awards, including university entrance scholarships for music studies, British Columbia Provincial Piano Finals and RCM Alumni awards for highest piano scores. He is a master teacher for the University of British Columbia Piano Pedagogy course and has been invited to adjudicate and give workshops throughout British Columbia.

Mr. Dupuis is director of West Point Grey School of Music, a Senior Piano Examiner and a member of the Canadian Music Festival Adjudicators' Association. He has previously been Chair of the Douglas College Music Advisory Committee and President of the Vancouver BC Music Teachers' Association.
