Edward Janus is a graduate of both the University of Toronto and The Royal Conservatory of Music, and has been a member of the faculty of The Royal Conservatory of Music since 1973 teaching piano and theoretical subjects. Boris Berlin was his principal teacher, and further studies were taken with Earle Moss and Madeline Bone.

In addition to his teaching duties, Mr. Janus has held numerous administrative positions at The Royal Conservatory of Music and served on various school committees. He served as principal of the Etobicoke branch of the RCM and was principal of the Mississauga Division of the RCM at its inception. He also served as Academic Officer of RCM Examinations from 1986 – 1996 during which time he helped to implement such new initiatives as Summer Examination sessions, and expansion into the USA.

Mr. Janus adjudicates festivals and conducts pedagogy seminars throughout Canada. He recently joined the executive of the Ontario division of the Canadian Music Competition.
