Ms. Falk Janzen has also studied at the University of Alberta and has participated in masterclasses with Jeanine Dowis and Marek Jablonski. She has been the recipient of numerous scholarships and awards, and in 1993 represented Manitoba in the piano competition at the CIBC National Music Festival in Victoria, B.C.

Ms. Falk Janzen has collaborated on two recordings with soprano Louella Klassen Friesen, *A Gift of Hope* in 1995, and *Endless Song* in 1997. She has participated numerous times with the Mennonite Festival Chorus, singing under the baton of Helmuth Rilling, Robert Shaw, and Bramwell Tovey. She has performed in 1998 and 1999 in the CBC Regina, SK *Waiting for a Star* fund-raiser for the Childrens' Wish Foundation.

Ms. Falk Janzen is also a published composer specializing in choral works as well as vocal solo and piano accompaniment, and some piano solo arrangements of hymns.
