Eileen Keown holds a diploma in piano performance from the Mozarteum in Salzburg and a Bachelor of Music from the University of Alberta. Ms Keown has performed extensively as a piano soloist, chamber musician, and accompanist in recitals and broadcasts, and she is also active as an adjudicator. She is a performing member as well as general manager of the Chamber Music Society of Mississauga. She has worked in the television industry and served as an administrator at Mount Royal College, Calgary. Other administrative positions include dean of the Community School at The Royal Conservatory of Music and executive director for the Toronto Mendelssohn Choir. Currently she is a faculty member of the Merriam School of Music.
