She was a piano coach for MusiCamrose for three years and was the ARMTA representative for the 1996 Esther Honens Calgary International Piano Competition Artistic Committee. An active member of the Alberta Registered Music Teachers' Association, she was provincial board member and past president of the Calgary Branch; was Chair of the Canadian Federation of Music Teachers' Association Conference held in Calgary in 2005; and was honored with the Alberta Registered Music Teachers' Association Recognition Award in 2006. In 2009 she taught at Ambrose University College.

Ms. Kundert-Stoll is an experienced teacher, collaborative pianist, adjudicator, and clinician. In addition, she has also been a reviewer and editor for the Frederick Harris Music Company. Her students have excelled in many disciplines and continue to receive awards locally and nationally.
