

# Jane Loewen

## Voice



Jane Loewen studied voice privately with Helen Simmie, and holds a Bachelor of Music degree (in voice and Music Education) from the University of Toronto. Her Royal Conservatory of Music credits include both Performer's and Teacher's A.R.C.T. diplomas in Singing, and Grade 10 in Piano. Her first love is performing, with a history that covers recital engagements, oratorio, opera, Broadway revues, and pop/jazz performances. In September 2003 Ms. Loewen produced and sang a solo show "Follow Your Bliss" (with John Gladwell on piano) at Toronto's Heliconian Hall, which was recorded on CD. Other local engagements include the lead role of Yum Yum in *The Mikado* with the Scarborough Gilbert & Sullivan Society, two years as a singer/pianist in the Victorian dinner theatre production, *Officers 1893*, the female lead in *A Little Night Broadway* at the Ford Centre for the Performing Arts, and several guest appearances with the Mississauga Festival Choir. Ms. Loewen is a member of the Toronto Musicians' Association and entertains frequently at private functions and local venues, often using her keyboard skills as well as her vocal talents. Ms. Loewen maintains a private studio at her home in Toronto and adjudicates at local music festivals. Until their closing in 1993, Ms. Loewen taught voice at the Etobicoke and Oakville branches of the Royal Conservatory of Music. Besides her teaching, she also maintains a business career as an IT consultant and writer.
