Wilson Man holds an ARCT in Piano Performance and a Licentiate in Piano Performance and Pedagogy from The Royal Conservatory of Music and a Bachelor of Music from the University of Toronto. Wilson Man is very active as a piano and theory instructor. He studied piano with Boyanna Toyich and theory with Dr. Dawson, William Andrews and Joe Ringhofer. Mr. Man also participated in masterclasses with Earle Moss in Hong Kong and attended lectures on stress reduction in performance. Winner of scholarships and prizes in competitions, he was a featured artist on the Television program Accolades in 1994. Between 1995 and 2000, he was the assistant conductor and accompanist for the Mississauga Children's Show Chorus. In addition to his teaching career, Mr. Man travels extensively across Canada as an adjudicator for music festivals. He continues to perform regularly as a soloist and accompanist and was part of the Calyx Concert Series (2000, 2001 seasons) and the Toronto Sinfonietta Series (2003). In August 2003, he was one of the performers in the first outdoor ten-piano-monster-concert held in Canada and Italy.
