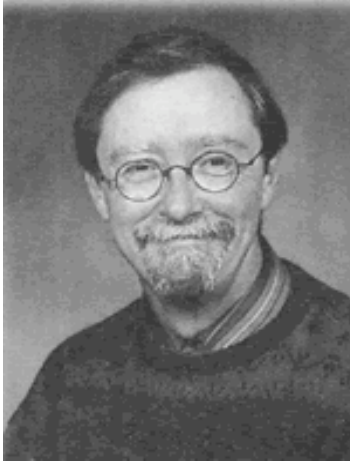


Eric Medhurst Piano and Organ



Degrees and Studies:

Eric Medhurst holds an ARCT Teacher's Diploma and an ARCT Piano Performer Diploma from The Royal Conservatory of Music. He also holds degrees in Music and Education from the University of Toronto. His principal teacher was Elsie Bennett, with further instruction from Marek Jablonski, concerning the repertoire of Chopin, and James Anaganson, concerning duo piano repertoire.

Mr. Medhurst has been a member of the teaching faculty at The Royal Conservatory of Music for thirty years and has been a member of the RCM Examinations College of Examiners for over twenty-five years.

Mr. Medhurst remains active as a performer. With his duo partner, Mr. John Graham, there have been many performances over the previous ten years. As a solo performer, Mr. Medhurst has presented lecture recitals of the Chopin Waltzes and Mazurkas, as well as other repertoire. He is the Organist and Choir Director of Graceview Presbyterian Church in Etobicoke and has also taught vocal music for the Peel Board of Education. In addition he is a composer of numerous choral works which have enjoyed success in the community.

Mr. Medhurst is a seasoned adjudicator for the Ontario Registered Music Teachers' Association, Kiwanis Music Festivals, the Davenport Festival and others. He conducts workshops across Canada and has written Keyboard Harmony papers for RCM Examinations. Recently he also collaborated on the new Organ Syllabus. In addition he is currently accompanist for the "Let There Be Music" Community Choir.
