Marcella Osmond holds a Bachelor of Music, and a Bachelor of Music Education, from Memorial University of Newfoundland. She has broad experience as a piano teacher, and was instructor of keyboard harmony at Memorial University's School of Music before moving to British Columbia in 1993.

Ms. Osmond has works published with Waterloo Music in Canada, and Boosey & Hawkes in the United States, and her choral arrangements have been recorded and performed internationally. Her writing includes articles for music magazines, and she was also a consultant for Piano Teacher's Pedagogical Guide Book. Throughout her career she has maintained a busy schedule as teacher, adjudicator, clinician, and organist & choir director, and for ten years, produced and directed annual full-scale staged musical productions.

Ms. Osmond's work in music-related fields has resulted in her being included in the Encyclopedia of Newfoundland. The Nfld. Youth Symphony Choir, Shallaway, has honoured her by establishing a scholarship in her name in recognition of her 'outstanding work with young Canadian musicians'.
