Fr. John Palmer holds an ARCT from The Royal Conservatory of Music, a L.T.C.L. and F.T.C.L. from Trinity College of Music, a Bachelor of Music from Acadia University, and a Master of Music from Northwestern University. He has studied with Felicita Kalejs, Earle Moss, and Jean Langlais.

Fr. Palmer has performed at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York, Columbia University in New York, St. James Cathedral in Toronto, St. Paul's Cathedral in London, England, and Organists in Recital for CBC Radio. He has adjudicated for the Downers Grove Music Competition and conducted workshops in "Personality and Interpretation in Music" and The Two Part Invention and Sinfonias of J.S. Bach. Fr. Palmer is a member of the Illinois State Music Teachers' Association, the Music Teachers' National Association, and the American Guild of Organists. He is currently a Professor in piano, organ, music history, and literature at Benedictine University in Lisle, Illinois.
