William Perry has been a member of the voice faculty of The Royal Conservatory of Music since 1971, following fourteen years of study with George Lambert. His additional studies include the Opera Division, University of Toronto, Westminster College, the Juilliard School of Music, and master classes with Gerard Souzay, Dalton Baldwin, William Parker, and Daniel Ferro. Mr. Perry's performing career has included solo appearances with the Toronto Mendelssohn Choir, the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, the Orpheus Choir of Toronto, the Bach-Elgar Choir of Hamilton, the Kingston Symphony, the Belleville Festival Choir and Orchestra, and the Ottawa Choral Society and Orchestra. He has been a member of the CBC Opera and the Canadian Opera Companies, and has been soloist on CBC broadcasts and recordings.

Mr. Perry was a vocal instructor and adjudicator at the University of Toronto, and is an experienced church organist and choirmaster. He was Musical Director for the premier performances of Canada's Centennial Play, produced by Dr. Nicholas Goldschmidt. Mr. Perry is a member of the Ontario Registered Music Teachers' Association, the Canadian Music Educators' Association, the Canadian Music Festival Adjudicators' Association, the Royal Canadian College of Organists, and the executive of The Royal Conservatory of Music Faculty Association.
