Heidi Peters holds a Bachelor of Music with Distinction and a Master of Music (performance, piano accompaniment major) from Brandon University, where her teachers included Gordon Macpherson, Kenneth Nichols, Peggy A. Now based in Winnipeg, she is active as a music educator, consultant, performer, researcher, and public speaker, and has three decades of experience as a respected piano, theory, and pedagogy instructor in university, conservatory, and private studio environments.

Ms Peters has appeared as a guest lecturer on topics such as student motivation and the prevention of musculoskeletal injuries for musicians. Her performing career includes nineteen years as leader of Duo à la Carte with woodwind player Julie Husband in school performances across Manitoba and north-western Ontario. She was also an information scout and contributor for the second edition of the Encyclopedia of Music in Canada and has worked as a music copyist for a number of composers and arrangers. She was a provincial adjudicator for the 2003 Canada Music Week Music Writing Competition.
