Rudy Mark Rozanski holds a Bachelor of Music, Master of Music and Doctorate of Musical Arts from the University of British Columbia. His teachers included Gyorgy Sebok, Menahem Pressler, Harold Zabrack, John Perry, and Robert Silverman. In the course of his studies he has received numerous awards, including several Banff Centre Scholarships and Killam Pre-Doctoral scholarships.

Dr. Rozanski has performed solo and chamber music concerts in Canada and the United States. He has been the concerto soloist with conductors such as Kazuyoshi Akiyama, Bruce Dunn, and David Hoyt. His broadcast performances include Tchaikovsky's Concerto in Bb, Rachmaninoff's Second Piano Concerto, and Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue. His recently released CD is a collection of piano miniatures entitled Reflections of Childhood.

Dr. Rozanski is a composer and arranger of acoustic and electronic music. His work in video and film includes the environmental documentary Estuaries of the Georgia Strait, the historical program Tsitslatsa, and the underscoring to the Touch the Sky Project (for children with cancer).
