David Sharpe holds an ARCT in Piano Performance from The Royal Conservatory of Music, a Bachelor of Music and a Bachelor of Education from Mount Allison University, and a Master of Music and a Doctor of Musical Arts in Piano Performance and Pedagogy from Arizona State University. Dr. Sharpe has performed both as soloist and chamber musician in the United States, Canada, Great Britain, and Germany. Among his awards are three-time state collegiate piano winner in Arizona, winner of the 1995 Atlantic Young Artist Competition, and awards for performance of contemporary music. Dr. Sharpe has led masterclasses and workshops, and has been a judge for various competitions. Past summer affiliations include programs at Adamant, VT, Las Vegas, NV, and Interlochen, MI. He has also taken part in conferences on piano pedagogy and has been a contributor to the American Music Teacher and Keyboard Companion publications. Currently, Dr. Sharpe studies law at the Sandra Day O'Connor College Law at Arizona State University.
