Marilyn Sinclair obtained her Solo Performers ARCT in Piano when she studied with Dorothy Bee at the Regina Conservatory, and her AMUS in Pipe Organ with Marguerite Buck. She was awarded the Saskatchewan Arts Board Bursary for two years to complete tuition, and the Provincial Pipe Organ Scholarship in 1963 and 1964. After moving to Alberta in 1968, she completed a Bachelor of Music with Distinction as well as a Bachelor of Arts in English Literature at the University of Lethbridge. She also completed a Licentiate diploma in Pipe Organ (Western board of Music). Ms. Sinclair has served on the National Board of the Canadian Federation of Music Teachers Association as well as President of the Alberta Registered Music Teachers Association and Vice President of Music Alberta. She has taught Group Piano Classes in the Lethbridge Piano Class Festival and has been the organist at McKillip United Church for 25 years. Ms. Sinclair was also the Alumni Representative to the University of Lethbridge Board of Governors from 1979 to 1985. Currently Ms. Sinclair is active as an adjudicator and clinician and maintains a private studio of Piano and Pipe Organ students.
