Suzanne Snelling holds a Bachelor of Music in Violin Performance from the Indiana University School of Music and has studied violin at the Eastman School of Music, Rochester, New York. She later studied with Mauricio Fuks in Montreal, and trained in the Suzuki method with Helen Brummer in Kingston, Ontario.

Ms. Snelling has performed in Canada and the United States as a soloist, chamber musician and orchestral player. She has been a member of L'orchestre symphonique de Quebec, the Hull Chamber Orchestra, and the Ottawa Symphony. She has taught violin privately in Quebec, Ontario and the United States, and has been a faculty member of the Children's Arts Centre in Kanata, Ontario and the Mississippi Arts Connection in Almonte, Ontario. She is also a member of the Musical Arts Club of Ottawa and a teaching member of the Kanata Music Club. Currently, Ms. Snelling maintains a private studio in Almonte, conducts an orchestra, coaches' chamber music, and gives school workshops.
