Jennifer Snow holds a Bachelor of Music from the University of Western Ontario, a Master of Music and a Doctorate of Music from Northwestern University. She has performed with many recognized artists such as Jens Lindemann of the Canadian Brass and Philip Smith of the New York Philharmonic, along with members of the Toronto Symphony, Montreal Symphony, National Arts Centre Orchestra, the Calgary Philharmonic, Orchestra London and the Millar Brass Ensemble of Chicago. Dr. Snow is also heard frequently on CBC Radio, and has played for the Showtime Network, TV Ontario, Edmonton Symphony Orchestra Series, Stratford Festival, ABC television and numerous colleges and universities.

Dr. Snow has presented workshops and participated in panels throughout Canada and the United States, recently presenting on the future of piano pedagogy at the World Piano Pedagogy conference in Las Vegas. Currently, Dr. Snow is a Visiting Associate Professor of Piano and Chamber Music at the University of California in Los Angeles, and also teaches piano pedagogy at the Glenn Gould Professional School of The Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto.
