Alan Young holds a Bachelor of Music and a Bachelor of Education from the University of Glasgow and a Licentiate Diploma in Piano Performance from the Royal Academy of Music, London, England. He also studied at the London Opera Centre. In England he served as assistant director of music at King's School, Worcester (the cathedral choir school), and later as head of music at a high school in northern England. During that time he taught piano and organ, conducted choral works, and directed operatic societies in performances ranging from grand opera to Gilbert and Sullivan. Mr. Young served as conductor for the North Yorkshire Youth Orchestra and as official accompanist at several competitive festivals.

Mr. Young came to Canada in 1985 as the organist and choirmaster at St Augustine's Anglican Church, Lethbridge, Alberta, a position which he continues to hold. He has served as coordinator of the Music Conservatory, University of Lethbridge, and for three years he was manager of the Lethbridge Symphony. He has a large private piano and organ class and is also active as an adjudicator.
