Candace de Lattre holds a Bachelor of Music in Vocal Pedagogy and Performance and a Master of Music in Performance from Michigan State University, where she studied with Leona Scheunemann Witter. She also holds a Specialist Diploma in Voice from the University of Michigan, where she studied with George Shirley, Katherine Hilgenberg, Eckhardt Pallheim, and Eugene Bossart. She continued her postgraduate education in New York, Toronto, and Graz, Austria, and has won a number of awards.

Ms. de Lattre maintains an active performing career and has sung with a number of opera companies across the United States and given concert performances and solo recitals in the United States, Canada, and Europe. In 1996 she founded DIVA!, a non-profit music school in Flint, Michigan. Ms. de Lattre directed the first ever Opera Workshop for Michigan Opera Theatre in its Learning at the Opera House series. She is the designer and director of the Summer Opera Camp at Michigan Opera for musically advanced high school students and college age adults. Ms. De Lattre is currently teaching voice at Cranbrook schools and applied voice and various classes for Oakland University.
