Degrees and Studies:

Catherine Lagopatis obtained her Bachelor of Music degree with a Major in Piano Performance from the McGill Faculty of Music and a Graduate Diploma in Advanced Music Performance Studies at Concordia University. For nine years, she was an Artist Associate in Concordia University's Leonardo Research Project. In 2006 she began a degree in music therapy at Université du Québec à Montréal.

Ms. Lagopatis has appeared as a soloist and ensemble performer throughout North America and Europe. Critically acclaimed for her "inspired musical intelligence" and "brilliance of execution", she builds her strikingly original programs out of a wide-ranging repertoire that features works by contemporary Hellene composers. Since 2003, she launched a project for the study of the classical musical heritage of Greece, focusing on works written for and with piano. The project's goal is to heighten the awareness, appreciation and dissemination of Greek composers internationally. The inaugural concert tour took place at Montreal's Place-des-Arts, as well as in Prague and Syros (Greece).

Ms. Lagopatis has received awards for Academic Excellence and Personal Distinction. She is active both in music therapy, focusing her work in psychiatry and as a piano pedagogue, adjudicator and performer.
